GPS location monitoring

With GPS-enabled Push to Talk handsets (eg BB3G), you have the unique ability of being able to locate and talk to your staff instantly. Push To Locate also provides historical information of your staff's movements.

Push To Locate Features and Benefits

- **Simple online access**
Monitor staff locations via a secure Instant Locate website, no software required.
- **Track of time**
Track movements of staff members over a specified period.
- **Locate without GPS data**
See approximate locations based on information from the mobile network if a GPS signal is not available, for example when indoors.
- **Lone worker**
Push to Locate also helps protect your lone workers as part of compliance with HSE and the Corporate Manslaughter Regulation. By ensuring that a supervisor can remain in constant touch and knows exactly where they are.
- **Improve customer service**
By accessing historical information about an employee's movement you can check, for example, whether a delivery person was at the correct address at the correct time, as well as the route that the employee took.
